Keep children safe with these tips to prevent accidental falls from a window.

**8 children under 5** die and another **3,300 children** are hospitalized every year due to injuries from window falls.\*



## **DON'T**



When young children are around, keep windows closed and locked.

Don't place furniture near windows to prevent young children from climbing and gaining access to an open window.



When opening a window for ventilation, use those located out of a child's reach.



Don't allow children to jump on beds or other furniture to help reduce potential falls.







Supervise children to keep child's play away from windows, balconies, and patio doors. Don't rely on insect screens to prevent a window fall. Insect screens are designed to keep bugs out, not keep children in the home.


